Children Classes

School Policies

What is the class format?

- There are between 2 and 6 students in a class.
- Classes meet once per week and lasts 1hr.

What is the focus of the classes?

- Our program is based on the idea that this learning can be significantly enhanced through the use of: Music, creative and visual aids, games, variety in presentation, and a relaxed and fun-filled environment.
- Students practice both speaking and reading/writing.
- Classes follow textbooks but have less than 1hr of homework per week.

Who will be teaching?

- ISL instructors are native speakers of the target language or are fluent to native-speaker level.
- ISL will do the best to keep the same instructor for each class; however, may need to substitute in an equally qualified instructor from time to time.

How long is an enrollment?

- Each session is different in length.
- After you complete the current session, you can re-enroll for the next level of the language on the same day/time with the same instructor.

Absence Policy:

- Refunds or credits are not provided for students' absences.
- With 24 hours notice: If another group at your level is meeting that week, you may attend it free of charge.

Payment Policies:

- Full payment must be made 48 hours before the first class to ensure a student's place in it.
- Refunds or credits are not provided for students' absences (see "Absences" above).
- Students may switch class sections at no cost!
- Refund policy:
 - Before the first class: Refunds must be requested at least three (3) days prior to the first day of class. A refund of 90% of your payment will be processed.
 - Once the session has started: Students may receive account credit upon request. 80% of unused tuition will be provided to the student and can be used to purchase classes, lessons or materials at ISL. This credit is valid for one year.
 - After two classes have taken place: No account credit or refund will be provided.
