Children Class Policies

- * **What is the class format?** There are between 2 and 8 students in a class.
- * **What is the focus of the classes?** Our program is based on the idea that this learning can be significantly enhanced through the use of: Music, creative and visual aids, games, variety in presentation, and a relaxed and fun-filled environment. Students practice speaking and listening skills as well as reading and writing. Classes follow textbooks and homework is assigned weekly.
- * **Who will be teaching?** ISL instructors are native speakers of the target language or are fluent to native-speaker level. ISL will do the best to keep the same instructor for each class; however, may need to substitute in an equally qualified instructor from time to time.
- * **How long is an enrollment?** Each session is different in length. After you complete the current session, you can re-enroll for the next level of the language on the same day/time with the same instructor.
- * **Absence Policy:**
 - ✓ Refunds or credits are not provided for students' absences.
 - ✓ With 24 hours notice: If another group at your level is meeting that week, you may attend it free of charge.
- * **Payment Policy:**
 - ✓ Full payment must be made 48 hours before the first class to ensure a student's place in it.
 - ✓ Refunds or credits are not provided for students' absences (see "Absences" above).
 - ✓ Students may switch class sessions at no cost (when available).
- * **Refund policy:**
 - ✓ Before the first class: Refunds must be requested at least three (3) days prior to the first day of class. A refund of 90% of your payment will be processed.
 - ✓ Once the session has started: Students may receive account credit upon request. 80% of unused tuition will be provided to the student and can be used to purchase classes, lessons or materials at ISL. This credit is valid for one year.
 - ✓ After two classes have taken place: No account credit or refund will be provided.

Class Levels

BEGINNER: For students with no or little language experience. Students will begin learning basic vocabulary and simple sentences to express personal information, where they live and people they know. Students will understand familiar words and basic phrases concerning themselves, their family and immediate concrete surroundings when others speak slowly and clearly.

Level A1.1:

- Beginner 2
- Beginner 3

HIGH BEGINNER: Students will begin learning phrases and sentences to describe in simple terms their family and other people, living conditions and their school environment. Students will understand phrases and the highest frequency vocabulary related to areas of most immediate personal relevance (e.g. very basic personal and family information, shopping, local area, school). They will catch the main point in short, clear, simple messages and announcements.

Level A1:

INTERMEDIATE — Students will be able to connect phrases in a simple way in order to describe experiences and events, dreams and hopes; to give reasons and explanations for opinions and plans' and to narrate a story. Students will also understand the main points of speech on familiar matters in school, leisure, etc.

ADVANCED — Students will be able to use the language in a more complex way, using the past tense and future tense with ease
