## Children Classes Information

#### Enrollment and Tuition

- Class size is 2 to 8 students.
- Classes meet once a week for 1 hour.
- Sessions are ongoing. Students may join at anytime as long as proficiency levels meet the class level. Payments will be prorated for classes missed upon enrollment.

#### Enrollment and Tuition

- Enrollment and payment is for a full session. If a student joins the session late, payment will be prorated for the missed classes.
- Payment must be made in full before the beginning of the session.
- Payments can be made with credit card or check. There is a \$25 fee for returned checks.

#### Refunds and Credits Policy

- Students who cancel more than one week prior to the class start date are entitled to a 90% refund of tuition paid.
- Students who cancel less than one week prior to the class start date are entitled to a 80% credit towards future classes.
- Students who cancel/discontinue within 2 weeks past the class start date are entitled to a 70% credit towards future classes.
- All requests for refunds and credits must be received by ISL in writing by the times listed above.
- No credits or refunds will be provided for cancelations after two weeks from the class start date.
- No refunds or credits are provided for absences.
- No refunds or credits on books and materials.

#### Make-up for Missed Classes

- Students enrolled in group classes are entitled to one make up lesson at a discounted rate of \$40/hr.
- Make-up lessons cannot be rescheduled once finalized; no refunds are given for cancelled make-up lessons.
- In the event of a class cancellation or inclement weather, a make-up class will be scheduled by ISL and all students will be informed. No alternative make-up dates will be offered for students who are unable to attend the make up session.

#### Discounts

*Early Bird* Discounts are available for each session when students register during the *Early Bird* Registration Period (TBD and announced for each session).

#### Staff and Academics

- ISL instructors are native speakers of the target language or are fluent to native-speaker level.
- ISL will do the best to keep the same instructor for each class; however, may need to substitute in an equally qualified instructor from time to time.
- ISL does not guarantee that students will pass any tests or exams.

## Class Levels

**BEGINNER:** For students with no or little language experience. Students will begin learning basic vocabulary and simple sentences to express personal information, where they live and people they know. Students will understand familiar words and basic phrases concerning themselves, their family and immediate concrete surroundings when others speak slowly and clearly.

**Level A1.1:**

- Beginner 1
- Beginner 2
- Beginner 3

**HIGH BEGINNER:** Students will begin learning phrases and sentences to describe in simple terms their family and other people, living conditions and their school environment. Students will understand phrases and the highest frequency vocabulary related to areas of most immediate personal relevance (e.g. very basic personal and family information, shopping, local area, school). They will catch the main point in short, clear, simple messages and announcements.

**Level A1:**

- High-Beginner 1
- High-Beginner 2
- High-Beginner 3

**INTERMEDIATE** — Students will be able to connect phrases in a simple way in order to describe experiences and events, dreams and hopes; to give reasons and explanations for opinions and plans' and to narrate a story. Students will also understand the main points of speech on familiar matters in school, leisure, etc.

**Level A2:**

**ADVANCED** — Students will be able to use the language in a more complex way, using the past tense and future tense with ease
